WORK CONDITIONS:

Draftsmen work primarily in an office environment but may be required to work in a manufacturing shop occasionally. The job is based in the continental U.S. but travel to various domestic locations to perform work may be required. Draftsmen must, also, be able to support internal and external customers in the oilfield. Many of these customers work seven days per week and well past "normal" business hours. When reasonable notice is given, the Draftsman may be called in past normal working hours to assist CES Engineers.
