ABOUT THE JOB:

The Service Line Supervisor coordinates and oversees the service line work at the well site. They provide necessary planning and instruction needed to correlate service activities, enhance operational methods and techniques and evaluate other service personnel. The Service Line Supervisor will be responsible for assisting the District Manager in supervising the activities of Service Specialists, Service Operators and Service Assistants while providing them with operational assistance and advice. In addition, they assist in monitoring the finances of the service line to help achieve the financial goals of the district. Another important aspect of their job would be to promote all CES safety programs and Company policies while continually expressing and enforcing the commitment to safety by:

- stopping any work in which a safety hazard has been identified until all affected parties are made aware of the possible hazard and all reasonable measures have been taken to mitigate the hazard;
- keeping current with all required safety training courses; and
- maintaining a safe driving record.

THE REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be legally authorized to work within the United States.
- Must be able to read, write and speak the English language in a manner that enables the employee to communicate effectively and safely in the workplace.
- Must be able to climb ladders/stairways to work on service equipment and must be able to lift and carry, for a distance of 50 feet, objects weighing 50 pounds.
- This position requires a high school education and a minimum of 6-8 years experience in an oilfield-related industry to include two years of Specialist experience or the equivalent thereof.
- You must also successfully pass company tests and meet competency task list requirements for this job.

WORK CONDITIONS:

Service Line Assistant's work in varied environments and, sometimes, in what may be considered harsh environments. Exposure to extreme temperatures, wind, precipitation, in addition to working at heights may be experienced when working in field or plant locations. In addition, they are required to travel to various geographical areas to perform work.
